MEDICATION/MEDICINE IN SCHOOL

The following is a review of Covenant Christian Academy's medication and medicine policy:

If your child requires prescription medicine while in school, please send it to the Academy office along with complete instructions from the doctor's office stating dosage and frequency. There is a form that should be filled out and signed by the parent or guardian that is kept in the medication log book.

Covenant Christian Academy is not permitted to administer over-the-counter medication such as aspirin, Tylenol, allergy pills, cough syrup, etc. In the event of an illness, a parent or guardian may permit Covenant Christian Academy to dispense such medications. The Parent or Guardian must present a written and signed note stating medication names, dosages and frequencies. All medications and medicines must be kept in the Academy office in a locked cabinet.

Students are not permitted to be in possession of any prescribed medications or over-the-counter medications.

Please review this policy with your child/children, and sign and return to the Covenant Christian Academy as soon as possible.
